

#### **MODULE 1: THE POWER OF RELATIONSHIPS**

#### The COR Model



Relationships result from repeated **interactions** over time. When positive and supportive, these moment-to-moment interactions build strong connections. Interactions filled with tension and conflict typically build negative relationships over time.

The ability to accurately **observe** classrooms impacts relationships. When you're able to step back and see what's really happening in your classroom, you'll have a stronger understanding of your students' needs and their behaviors.

**Awareness** of your own – and others' – beliefs, perceptions, and feelings impacts a relationship. Our thoughts, feelings, and perceptions, molded by past experiences, influence how we act and react, how we observe and interpret behaviors, and how we act in future situations.



## MODULE 2: BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS THROUGH AWARENESS


### MODULE 4: INTERACTIONS THAT PROMOTE FEELING CAPABLE AND VALUED
