School emergency preparedness and training should be all-inclusive of any staff members who work on a school site with youth during school and out-of-school hours, including after-school, before school, weekends and summer. Staff working with students, pre-K to Grade 12, whether employed by the school/district or another public or non-public entity, should be provided training that gives them the necessary tools and resources to keep all children safe in times of trauma, crises and/or natural disasters. This training session will provide guidance in partnering and collaborating with the host school to align with existing school emergency preparedness plans.

Andrew Roszak

Mr. Roszak's current professional service includes work as the Executive Director for the Institute for Childhood Preparedness, as Chief of Preparedness, Health and Environment for the Region 2 Head Start Association, and as a professor for Old Dominion University. Previously, he has served as the Senior Director for Emergency Preparedness at Child Care Aware of America, Senior Preparedness Director of Environmental Health, Pandemic Preparedness, and Catastrophic Response at the National Association of County and City Health Officials; at the MESH Coalition and the Health and Hospital Corporation of Marion County, Indiana, as the Senior

Preparedness Advisor supporting Super Bowl 46 and the Indianapolis 500; as a Senior Advisor for the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services; on the Budget and HELP Committees of the United States Senate; and at the Illinois Department of Public Health.

Before becoming an attorney, Andrew spent 8 years as a firefighter, paramedic, and hazardous materials technician in the Chicagoland area. In addition to his 20-plus year preparedness career, Mr. Roszak has spent the past 3 years laser focused on early childhood programs and providers. Through his work, he has provided training to tens of thousands of early childhood professionals.

In 2016, Mr. Roszak developed the first active shooter training program designed for early childhood professionals. In addition to preparedness training, Mr. Roszak currently oversees the early childhood disaster recovery work in the US Virgin Islands and in Puerto Rico.
