As NJ educators begin to engage in the CAR process to support teaching and learning for the state's diverse student population, educators need to engage in rich and deep conversations that lead to new solutions that address challenging academic and socio-emotional issues. Adaptive challenges require collaborative exploration, discovery, and innovation. Collaborative inquiry unleashes the resourcefulness and creativity of educators to continuously improve instruction so all students reach standards of excellence. It situates professional learning in iterative cycles of shared data analysis, practice, dialogue and reflection around one's own practice (Problems of Practice). During this two-day learning opportunity participants will examine the benefits and characteristics of collaborative inquiry; experience steps in the inquiry process; discover the supportive conditions for inquiry, and discover ways to effectively implement collaborative inquiry in schools and districts.

By the end of this first day of the 2-day professional learning experience participants will:

- Value the benefits of Collaborative Inquiry.
- Understand how collaborative inquiry accelerates equitable outcomes through the CAR process
- Explain the purposes of each step in the Inquiry Cycle.
