In this **FREE** webinar, participants will receive a summary of the latest information on the 2019 Novel Coronavirus, or COVID-19, from the New Jersey Department of Education and New Jersey Department of Health, as well as from the CDC.

Participants will be provided with the most up-to-date information on the following:

- Confirmed cases
- Potential indicators of infection
- At-risk populations
- Responding to students or staff who may be quarantined or otherwise be absent
- Preventative measures that should be taken
- Key elements of required district plans for potential health-related school closures that include how to still address the 180-day requirement.

This webinar will include a review of key factors to be addressed in district plans related to home instruction in lieu of school attendance such as equitable access for all students, the provision of special education and related services, and the provision of nutrition benefits for eligible students.

Finally, participants will receive guidance on addressing the stigma and discrimination that may occur when people associate an infectious disease with a population or nationality, including the potential harmful impact on Asian Americans, immigrant students generally and the Jewish Community.
